ACCESSIBLE ENTRANCE DETAILS

54 Regional Drive, Concord, NH

- Push pad for entering the door into the lobby is on the left-hand side of the entrance.
- The door opens to the interior for seven (7) seconds.
- When you enter the lobby, there are three chairs on the right-side wall.
- Above the first chair (closest to where you came in) is the push pad to exit.
- Along the left wall are 2 desks side-by-side with computer monitors on them.
- The width of the walking path between the furniture on either wall is about 4 feet.
- The receptionist's window is 10 paces from the entrance and on the left side of the rear wall.

VISITOR PROCEDURES

- You must sign in with the receptionist and be escorted to your destination.

If the receptionist is not there, there is an intercom to the right of the reception window with a call button and a braille sign with instructions, as well as a bump dot on the microphone, which you press and release once.

- The receptionist has a protruding counter with a cut-away window for access.
- You will be given a guest pass which must stay with you for the duration of your visit and returned when you leave the building.
